ECONOMY

- Create a "Marshall Plan" with Africa in order to create working opportunities for youth and prevent departures from these countries
- Fight for equal opportunities for women in the labor market
- Increase the European Fund for Transition to help those who lose their jobs due to digitalization and globalization
- Create 5 million new jobs across the EU to stop brain drain by investing in infrastructure and innovation
- Make it easier for companies and entrepreneurs to get financing
- Ensure that the EU industrial and competition policy will allow global champions to be built in Europe
- Modernize the Common Agricultural Policy to make it more sustainable and results-drive

Environment

- Ensure an effective price on CO2 with a well-functioning EU ETS and further incentivize emission reductions in the industry and energy sectors
- Facilitate investments in innovative low-carbon technologies (including e-mobility)
- Build a true Energy Union, where electricity and gas can cross borders without obstacles

SOCIAL POLICIES

- Support investment in the area of health to combat the challenges arising from an ageing population
- Reform the Common European Asylum System and establish a European Return Warrant System to ensure the return of rejected asylum seekers to their countries of origin
- Introduce a digital tax to ensure that digital giants pay their fair share of financing of the EU's digital infrastructure
- Abolish over 1.000 outdated and unnecessary regulations, and cutting the number of bureaucrats in the EU institutions to make the system more efficient
